- Recruit, train, and develop small group systems and leaders that reflect the vision and mission of Edinbrook Church for all 6th-8th grade
- Assist in the implementation of DYMU and other leadership development models.

Worship Ministry

- Assist with the implementation and execution of worship ministry on Wednesday Nights and various retreats
- Help to develop a volunteer to assist with Youth Band

Pastoral Care

- Assist in areas of pastoral care and counselling as needed in relation to students and volunteers.
- Keep Supervisors appraised of pastoral care needs that arise

Student Ministry Events

- Attend and act as Point Leader on all Middle School Student Ministry events
- Attend and support all Combined (MS/HS) Student Ministry events
- Plan and brainstorm calendar of annual events for all Student Ministry events

Communication

• Ensure clear channels of communication to parents regarding all upcoming events and Middle School Student Ministry happenings

 Develop ways to keep parents informed about current series topics and develop ways for them to engage as appropriate

Family Ministry

• Engage in all Fight For Family events appropriate to student and kid's ministry collaboration
